

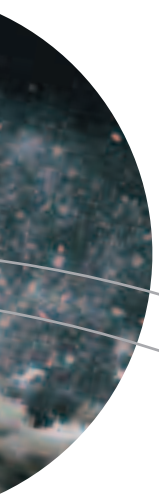

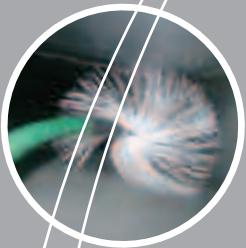
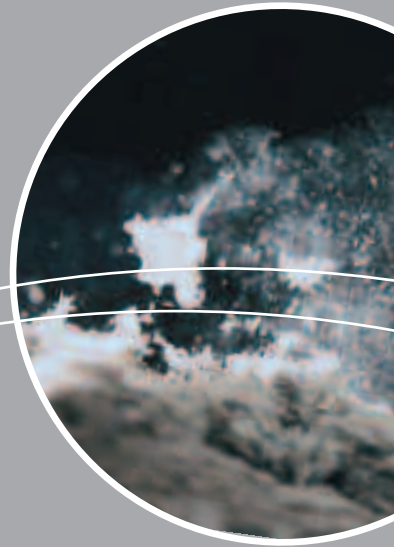

ENVIRONMENTAL SOFT STRIP

EMSS have been challenged with difficult and demanding requirements when soft stripping and dismantling prior to asbestos remediation. These challenges have resulted in unique solutions when considering minimising environmental impact, for example recycling of waste materials such as timber, metals, glass, etc. By developing Critical Success Factors and Key Performance Indicators we have measured waste and ensured that where recycling is possible this is carried out and minimal environmental impact is delivered.

All dusts can be dangerous if not controlled, and EMSS have focused on reducing dust emissions when dismantling, shredding and disposing of non-hazardous wastes through LEV (local exhaust ventilation) techniques.

VENTILATION HYGIENE SURVEYING AND VALIDATION

As part of our commitment to improving the standards within the duct cleaning industry, we have designed and developed, in partnership with a leading software house, our Ventilation Management Programme (V.M.P.).

V.M.P. has been designed to ensure that, when we are asked to survey the cleanliness and condition of your ventilation systems, either an interactive CD Rom or a hard copy of the V.M.P. report is provided with all the information needed at your fingertips. V.M.P. will highlight key areas of risk such as heavy deposits, inoperable fire dampers, damaged duct sensors, internal corrosion, etc. and contains digital images and CCTV footage to visually evidence the internal condition of the system.

V.M.P. is a tool for managing the cleanliness of ventilation and ducting systems and perfectly fits the design ideal above.

It is relatively easy to manage the cleaning requirements for a single ventilation duct. What happens, however, if there are hundreds of ventilation systems spread out through multiple sites? The answer is to use our Ventilation Management Programme.

Full reports can be generated for each site showing the situation at the current time. The report includes all the information from the survey including all recommendations and action taken. The main report sections are as follows.

- Contact information
- Site description and system descriptions
- Survey requirements and techniques
- Cleaning and access requirements
- Cleaning techniques
- Risk factors
- Reservations
- Recommendations
- Test point records

V.M.P. is capable of storing pictures and video for each system and these can be viewed within the programme itself. Please note that in the case of video the operating system of the computer used must also support the video file format. Closed circuit television camera footage shows clearly the internal condition of a duct before and after cleaning. Some examples of CCTV footage are included here.

This new legislation is a fire risk assessment based approach where the responsible person(s) for the premises must decide how to address the risks identified. This risk assessment must include the catering facilities grease extract system as this is a potential high risk area, and subsequent action must be taken to reduce this risk by removal of the flammable grease deposits.”
